

Title:	Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Rugby League (UKCC)

Who is it for:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The level 2 Coaching Course is suitable for those with some experience of rugby league and the requirements of coaching. The course focuses and develops the principles of coaching outlined in the Level 1 Coaching Certificate. This is the standard qualification for coaches operating within the community game, at 13 a side and open age, or coaches who have worked as level 1 coach for two years who now wish to progress. Applicant's who have not successfully completed Level 1 Coaching may apply; however, they will only be accepted if they have the support of the Regional Talent Coach who must confirm that they are suitable and capable of successfully completing the course. It is recommended that the applicant has played at open age for a minimum of 3 years and supported a coach for a minimum of 1 year.
